Our children's' courses are well-structured and planned around students' tastes and interests. We also play many games, which are designed to help with structure and confidence. All lessons revolve around activities which can include making things, music, eating etc.

Suggested topics may include:

Tasty Treats : Colour and Shape : Music and Movement : Dressing Up : Animals : All Sing Together : Play Piano : Make a Movie : Face Painting

We do activities which can relax children and create a more natural situation for learning language. Differentiated versions of the course are available for children who have reached different levels with their English. The course will also offer them a chance to learn other skills at the same time.

Students in this group will have their learning interspersed by games, role-play and other challenges, and will develop the confidence to interact with native English speakers in a variety of capacities. At this stage, there may be some writing at a basic level.

Students in the group will be able to select their preferred topics at the start of the course. Some help from parents would be appreciated, particularly with younger children.

The course will commence with a short informal test suitable for the age concerned to ascertain language levels and a settling in activity. At this age, this will most likely involve a chat with the teacher.

All courses may include the use of video, audio materials, written materials, intensive speaking practice, activities,

grammatical work where requested, and opportunities to engage with ordinary native speakers. There may be a trip out of the classroom into an English-speaking environment by arrangement with parents.

The emphasis of the course will be on building a bridge between classroom activities and the real world.

The course will finish with a presentation for parents or other extended activity and a report by the main teacher.
